When Temptation Comes

Just when we seem to be making spiritual headway in our lives, the likelihood for intense personal temptation increases. Jesus as he was about to burst onto the scene in Jerusalem, was faced with the Tempter's luring promises.

With prayer and determination, Jesus resisted each temptation. And St. Luke records that "when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed until an opportune time" (Luke 4:13). In other words, Satan scurried away to wait for a better time, perhaps when Jesus' guard was down. It is that same "opportune time" the Tempter seeks in each of us. When our spiritual welfare seems on course, when all seems well, too often we relax feeling secure in our faith, and Satan steps up with a new delicious suggestion. And at these times we will stand strong only if we follow the advice and example of Jesus: "Pray," our Lord said, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation" (Luke 22:40).
