Turn To Me

Lent is a time of repentance, when we are called to turn away from sin and return to a faithful walk with the Lord. In Hebrew the word for repentance is teshuvah, which comes from the root word, shuvah, meaning "to turn", like the turning of the earth to the sun, or the turning of soil before planting. This Lenten season, let us turn over the sin dead soil of hearts, planting His word deep in fresh soil, so that as we turn our faces to Him we will grow in the light of His Son.
