

Yet so many times in life, our security blankets can begin to unravel or even be cut up. This may be one of the reasons Jesus was not so popular with the "in crowd" of His day: He threatened their security. He "hung out" with those who were not popular, or those who were looked upon by society as not being "right" with God. So it is good to know that God is there for us when our security blankets begin to fall apart. He remains as a constant, forgiving and welcoming. The lesson from this wonderful and well-known story of the prodigal child helps us to know that security is not found in inheritances or jobs or power or relationships. Security is found in a relationship with a loving God, who we find fully expressed in Jesus Christ.
