A Different Kind Of Glory

When we think of glory, we often think of something splashy and bright. The last thing we would think of is a cross. Yet that is exactly what Jesus tells us in today's reading. The glory of God is the cross of Christ. In the cross, Jesus shares his peoples struggles through the hurricanes of life. In the cross, Jesus stands in the cloud of suffering with us. It doesn't sound like any glory we're used to. It doesn't shine with acclaim, honor or adulation. Instead, this glory glows with the fire of God's love for the world. This is the "splendor veritatis," the "shining of the truth," which lights our world until Jesus comes again.
