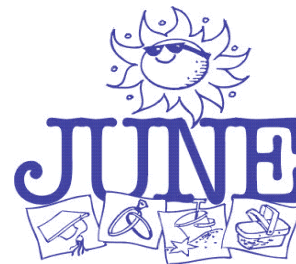
A Father's Prayer
