

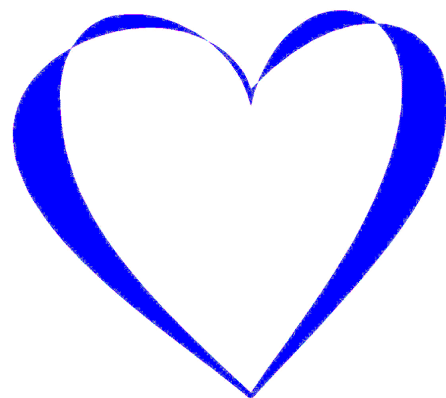

BIBLE STUDY

This year we will study the Gospel of Matthew. It is a 24 week Bible Study beginning in late September to November and finishing in January to April.
